

# Welcome to NWLG's Fourth Annual Lavender Festival

## Lavender Fields Forever

**July 19 - 20, 2008**

Dear Artisan:

We invite you to participate in our celebration of lavender. We look forward to a wonderful experience for you and our guests. Following is information you will need for the Festival. If you have any questions please call or email. Either Kelly or I will get back to you as soon as possible.

- Jurying of Crafts:** All crafts sold at the Lavender Festival must be juried. All applications must list **all** crafts sold by the artisan and be postmarked by March 31, 2008. We require two photos of your crafts. We accept printed photos, CD's labeled with your name and phone number, or jpeg format by email. Return postage is required if you wish your pictures or cd's returned. If you have additional crafts not listed on the application you have until May 1, 2008 to have the crafts juried. The Lavender Guild reserves the right to inspect and observe the crafting process at the artisan's residence or place of business. All crafts must be the work of the artisan. No wholesaling is allowed. Crafts original in concept are encouraged.
- Fees:** The fee is \$ 50.00 for non-members, \$ 30.00 for members of the Lavender Guild per booth space. Include the fee with you application. Your Check will not be cashed until you are notified of acceptance. **Deadline for refund is May 1, 2008.**
- Nursery Plants:** Plants must be grown by the vendor for a minimum of six weeks. Please list the types of plants you will be selling. **Lavender plants may only be sold by members of the Lavender Guild.** Water is available for plants.
- Class Demos:** If you would like to give a demo about your craft let us know. There is a cabin available or you can demonstrate at your booth.
- Setup & Security:** You may setup your booth space on either Friday, July 18th starting at 12:00 noon until 8:00 pm or on Saturday July 19<sup>st</sup> starting at 6:00 am until 9:00 am. Please have all vehicles in the vendor parking area by 9:15 am at the latest. We will have some help available for carrying and setting up. Night time security will be provided but you should secure any valuable items. The entrance to the Festival site will be locked Friday night and Saturday night.
- Booth space:** We will have a map available Friday that will show vendor placement. A vendor space is 10 x 10. Water will be available for plants. The vendor area is in a sunny meadow with a pond. Canopies or ez-ups are strongly recommended as July can be quite warm and sunny. You must secure your canopy or ez-ups as the wind can come up and blow them down. You will be responsible for any damage caused by an unsecured canopy or ez-up. All vehicles must be moved to the vendor parking area during the hours of the Festival. There is no tailgating.
- Hours:** Festival hours will be 10:00 am to 6:00 pm on Saturday and 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. Sunday. We ask that you have your booth ready by 9:30 the opening of the Festival and **DO NOT** takedown your booth before 4:00 pm Sunday when the Festival closes.
- Camping:** Both tent and RV camping is available onsite for vendors and there is no charge. It will be a dry camp but water will be available. There is a motel in Athol and RV camping is available at Silverwood. There are bed and breakfasts in the area. If you would like additional information let us know.
- Food:** We will have a good selection of food available. Volunteers will take orders and deliver during the Festival.
- Medical:** We will have EMTs available if there is any medical emergency.

**Children: Must be under adult supervision at all times**

**Dogs:** We all have great and wonderful dogs, but they are not allowed at the Festival. Please leave them at home. Visitors will also be asked to leave their dogs at home.

**Admission:** Admission for adults will be \$2.00 with children under 6 free. Two vendor passes will be mailed after you are juried into the Festival. If you forget your pass you will have to pay at the gate and will be reimbursed.

**Resale No.:** All vendors must pay any taxes due from sales at the Lavender Festival. The State of Idaho requires all vendors to fill out an event form. We will collect this form at the Festival and return it to the State.
